Application is due to your Career Coordinator by March 3rd.

Max Cerini Memorial Scholarship (All Petaluma High Schools)
(2) \$1,000 scholarships available to a student who is pursuing a career in the construction or building industry at a college, university or trade school.

Cleveland - U'Ren Teen Mother Scholarship - (All Petaluma high schools)
\$500 available to a teen mother who is planning to further her education at trade school, apprenticeship/vocational program or a 2 or 4-year college.

Maxwell and Doris Decker RN Scholarship- (All Petaluma high schools)
\$2000 to a senior graduating from any Petaluma area high school who wishes to pursue a degree in nursing and has at least a 3.0 GPA. The scholarship will be renewable each year for up to 4 years provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and has a minimum of 9 units per semester working towards a degree in nursing.

Pat Doherty Memorial Scholarship - (All Petaluma high schools)
\$1000 each to a girl and boy who has a 3.0 or greater GPA, participated in athletics and will be attending a 4-year college, with financial need.

Fishman Family Scholarships - (All Petaluma high schools)
Up to \$500 scholarship available to students from any Petaluma high school who are graduates of Penngrove elementary school, going to a 4 year college and who have been involved in the community.

Connie and Bill Hammerman Vocational Scholarship - (All Petaluma schools) \$500.00 scholarship to a student who plans on vocational training at a trade school.
(*electrical, mechanics, agriculture etc.*)

Henris Family Scholarship - (All Petaluma high schools)
(10) \$500 scholarships available to students for study in a vocational program at a 2 or 4-year college or trade school.

Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Scholarship - (All Sonoma County high schools) - \$500 available to a student who promotes principles of non-violence, peace, justice and human understanding. This is open to all Sonoma County high school students. Financial need maybe considered. **Additional Essay Required.** *Write a brief essay describing why your activities in school and in the community qualify you for a scholarship honoring the life and work of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Need not to exceed one page.*

Kiwanis Community Service Scholarship. - (All Petaluma High Schools) - \$1,000 to a graduating student going to a 4 year college who has performed outstanding community service. No GPA requirement.

Petaluma Sunrise Rotary Scholarship - (San Antonio HS, Carpe Diem HS, Sonoma Mountain HS, Valley Oaks HS) - \$250 for a student from the alternative high school who plans a career in vocational programs.

Cynthia Terzian Memorial Scholarship - (All Petaluma Schools)
(2) \$500 scholarships to students who plan to enter culinary school at the S.R.J.C. or other school.

Drs. Woo and DeBerardinis Orthodontic Science Scholarship
(All Petaluma high schools)
(3) \$500 available to a student with 3.0 GPA or high and showing academic interest in the health sciences and plans on attending a 2 or 4 year college.
